### to give your opinion of a movie or program

<b>cómico, -a</b>	funny
<b>emocionante</b>	touching
<b>fascinante</b>	fascinating
<b>infantil</b>	for children; childish
<b>realista</b>	realistic
<b>tonto, -a</b>	silly, stupid
<b>violento, -a</b>	violent
<b>me aburre(n)</b>	it bores me (they bore me)
<b>me interesa(n)</b>	it interests me (they interest me)

### to ask and tell about movies or programs

<b>el actor</b>	actor
<b>la actriz</b>	actress
<b>dar</b>	to show
<b>durar</b>	to last
<b>empezar (e → ie)</b>	to begin
<b>terminar</b>	to end
<b>más / menos de</b>	more / less than
<b>medio, -a</b>	half
<b>¿Qué clase de . . . ?</b>	What kind of . . . ?

### to talk about what has just happened

<b>acabar de + infinitive</b>	to have just . . .
-------------------------------	--------------------

### verbs similar to *gustar*

<b>aburrir</b>	to bore
<b>doler (o → ue)</b>	to hurt, to ache
<b>encantar</b>	to please very much, to love
<b>faltar</b>	to be missing
<b>interesar</b>	to interest
<b>quedar</b>	to fit

### other useful expressions

<b>antes de</b>	before
<b>casi</b>	almost
<b>¿De veras?</b>	Really?
<b>especialmente</b>	especially
<b>por eso</b>	therefore, for that reason
<b>sobre</b>	about
<b>ya</b>	already
